

CTG successfully provided video transport service for World Figure Skating Championships 2015

(29 April 2015, Hong Kong) China Telecom Global (CTG) was the support unit for network communications in the World Figure Skating Championships 2015 with its Media Distribution and Exchange service, in which CTG provided TV signal pick-up, national transmission and international connection. The World Figure Skating Championships 2015 was held on 23-29th March in Shanghai with 166 participants from 37 countries and 141 media partners from 18 countries.

During the whole period, CTG provided a 100% available on demand service to offer 29 hours of live broadcast so that it could meet the flexibility requirements and the service received high recognition from global partners. This MDX service has filled the gap of the export of videos in China and met with the international standards and model for media video transmission service. Through the always-connected MDX platforms in Shanghai and Hong Kong, the demand for temporary, short-term and long-term business can be satisfied and it significantly enhanced CTG's competitiveness in the fierce market for media video transmission as a quality and quantity value-added service to the IPLC services.

To ensure smooth transmission of video and text for local and overseas media partners, CTG worked with China Telecom Shanghai branch to set up 3 high-speed gigabyte dedicated broadband in Shanghai Oriental Sports Center and Sanlin Sports Center to set up a 2+1 route with dual passageway and backup, and extended the 1+1 dual backup long distance circuit from Shanghai to the MDX (Media Distribution & eXchange) Center in Hong Kong to dock with overseas partners and customers. Before launch of the event broadcast, CTG and China Telecom Shanghai branch conducted different on-site surveys with major Chinese, Japanese and European TV companies for project optimization and this broadcast covered various TV stations in Japan, Europe and China.

This high usability and quality service was delivered by sending the HD SDI signals from the venue to the HD encoders to be switched to 2 Nimbra 360 system through video signal switching matrix, and then sent to the 2 Nimbra 360 in Hong Kong MDX Hub through 2 different physical cable routes of STM-1 long distance circuits, and finally to different partner devices through the video signal switching matrix.

Meanwhile, CTG will continue to enhance and diversify its MDX products and services to offer different video solutions to support upcoming global events to be held in China for its global customers.
